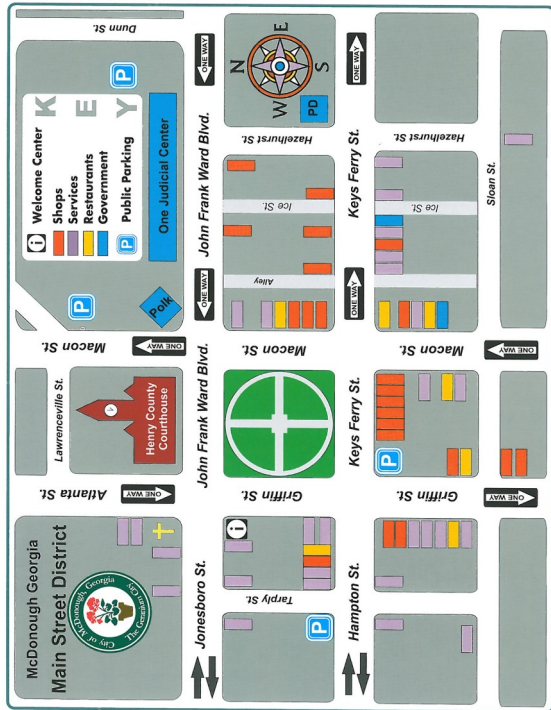


MAIN STREET MCDONOUGH PROGRAM
